



Registration is now open for the 2020 AAAP Virtual Annual Meeting

The American Association of Avian Pathologists announces that [registration is now open](#) for the 2020 AAAP Virtual Annual Meeting. This registration is separate from the AVMA. If you pre-registered with the AVMA, make sure you have called AVMA to cancel.

Presentations will be available on-demand from July 31 to September 4, and CE credits will be available to those who register and view the presentations. You are encouraged to view the presentations in advance of the live Q&A sessions on August 4-5th. You are also encouraged to send in questions for the speakers after the course and during the live Q&A sessions for the speakers to address.

The program will consist of pre-recorded presentations called “lessons” which are divided into topic categories called “courses.” Each course will contain up to 10 lessons for 2.5 hours of CE. Some courses may have less than 10 lessons so you will receive the proportioned amount of CE. To complete a course and receive CE credit, you will have to view all the lessons in the course.
